During this time I have traveled to seven different countries to perform solar surveys and have installed or repaired over twenty solar systems.

My passion for solar energy began in 1991 when I built my own solar powered home. Since 2003, I’ve been professionally designing and installing solar systems as a living. But I’ve had a growing passion to use my professional skills to serve the Lord full time ever since my salvation in 1993.

Through volunteering with I-TEC, I’ve witnessed firsthand the desperate need for cost-effective, reliable solar power and have tried to juggle volunteering with my desire to provide for my family. However, the growing demands coupled with the desire to use my skills to serve have become greater than I can offer as a part-time volunteer. April and I believe that I should begin to pursue my passion and move into full-time solar missions with I-TEC.
